3. Consumer Consent

2. validating eligible electric vehicle purchases, which involves reviewing the vehicle identification number and the date of birth and postal code of the purchaser / lessee.

The personal information collected will be shared only with those employees of the Program Administrator and the Department of Energy & Mines as is reasonably required for the administration and evaluation of the Program. Under the provisions of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, individuals have the right of access to, correction of and protection of their personal information.
